- _____ Sleeping Bag in plastic lined stuff bag

- _____ Sleeping Clothes to be worn only in sleeping bag, can be t-shirt and gym shorts or long underwear.
- _____ 2 or 3 20 to 30 gallon garbage sacks
- _____ 2 or 3 10 to 13 gallon garbage sacks
- _____ First aid kit (see scout book page 289 plus 1 space blanket)
- _____ 3 foot by 3 foot piece of tarp for clean cooking area
- _____ Insect repellent (non aerosol)
- _____ flashlight small size with extra batteries and bulb
- _____ Sun glasses (can be used for first aid kit eye protection).
- _____ Sun screen at least spf 15
- _____ lip balm (the kind with sun screen is best)
- _____ Pocket knife (folding or lock back blade not longer then 3 inches)
- _____ Tooth brush/ tooth paste (small tube)
- _____ Hand towel
- _____ Toilet paper
- _____ Matches in waterproof container.
- _____ Fire Starter (only bring one)
- _____ Cup – Measuring style, Preferable non metal
- _____ Deep Bowl (non metal)
- _____ Plate (non metal)
- _____ spoon and fork (preferably Lexon (non metal))

Clothing CHECK MISSING ITEMS ONLY

- ___ Hiking boots, or camp shoes (freshly water proofed)
- ___ 4-6 plastic grocery bags (for wet shoe liners)
- ___ 2 or 3 pair of wool or hiking socks
- ___ 2 pair of long under ware pants (wool or poly preferred but cotton can be used)
- ___ 2 pair of long under ware tops (wool or poly preferred but cotton can be used)
- ___ 1 turtle neck shirt or 1 turtle (poly neck collar)
- ___ 1 stocking cap (can be worn at night in bed)
- ___ Hat with brim
- ___ 2 outer pants (should not be cotton, but cotton can be used)
- ___ 2 outer shirts (should not be cotton, but cotton can be used)
- ___ 1 sweater or poly pull over. (will except sweat shirt)
- ___ 1 coat
- ___ 1 sturdy rain pants (should fit over under ware and outer pants)
- ___ 1 sturdy rain coat (should fit over all upper clothing)
- ___ 1 pair of gloves: wool or poly liner glove.
- ___ 2 T-shirts
- ___ 2 under pants (optional)
- ___ 2 bandana or handkerchiefs (this should your only cotton clothing)
- ___ 1 **Pair of work gloves: leather or cotton (mandatory)**

Group Equipment CHECK MISSING ITEMS ONLY

- ___ Pots and Pans appropriate for planned meals
- ___ Single burner stoves and fuel (enough to cook meals)
- ___ Cooking utensils appropriate for planned meals
- ___ Serving utensils
- ___ Camp soap (biodegradable for every washing need)
- ___ Dish washing sponge / scrubber pad (absolutely **no** S.O.S or soaped steel wool pads)
- ___ Dish towels (cotton or “camp towels”)
- ___ collapsible water containers (recommend 2, 2 to 3 gallon size over over 1 5gallon size, 5 gallon to heavy for scouts to carry easily.
- ___ Tents enough for all scouts in group can be 2 2man tents or a single 4 man. (should have vestibules)
- ___ Tarp to serve as a ground cloth under tent
- ___ Sheet of 2 to 4 mil plastic to line the inside of the tent floor.
