- _____ First aid kit (see scout book page 289 plus 1 space blanket)
- _____ 3 foot by 3 foot piece of tarp for clean cooking area **

- _____ Sun glasses (can be used for first aid kit eye protection).
- _____ Sun screen at least spf 15

Clothing

- ___ Scout Uniform
 - ___ Shirt with proper patches (Required)
 - ___ Neckerchief (Required)
 - ___ Neckerchief slide (Required)
 - ___ Belt (optional)
 - ___ Scout Pants (optional)
- ___ Swim Trunks
- ___ Hiking boots, or camp shoes (freshly water proofed)
- ___ Tennis shoes/ camp shoes
- ___ shower shoes/ swim shoes (close toes sandals similar to a Crocs, etc)
 - ___ NOTE: OPEN TOED SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON TRAILS
 - ___ OR WALKING TO OR FROM SHOWER/ SWIMMING AREAS
 - ___ OR IN CAMP AREA.
- ___ 4-6 plastic grocery bags (for wet shoe liners)
- ___ 2 or 3 pair of wool or hiking socks
- ___ Dailey change of under wear and socks
- ___ 1 pair of long underwear pants (wool or poly preferred but cotton can be used)
- ___ 1 pair of long under ware tops (wool or poly preferred but cotton can be used)
- ___ 1 turtle (poly neck collar)
- ___ 1 stocking cap (can be worn at night in bed)
- ___ Hat with brim
- ___ 2 pair of shorts or cutoffs
- ___ 1 or 2 of long pants for service work, etc.
- ___ 2 outer shirts (should not be cotton, but cotton can be used)
- ___ 1 sweater or polypropylene pull-over. (will except sweat shirt)
- ___ 1 coat
- ___ 1 sturdy rain pants (should fit over under ware and outer pants)
- ___ 1 sturdy rain coat (should fit over all upper clothing)
- ___ 1 pair of gloves: wool or poly liner glove.
- ___ 4 activity shirts or other t-shirts
- ___ 2 bandana or handkerchiefs
- ___ 1 **Pair of work gloves: leather or cotton (mandatory)**

_____ Travel lunch and car snacks

Get drivers permission as they may not allow eating or drinking in their car.

THE FOLLOWING SHOULD BE ARRANGED WITH CAMP SCOUTMASTER BEFORE BRINGING:

_____ Cooking gear for planned meals for camping before camp week
(Friday, Saturday and Sunday Morning)

Fuel storage is regulated at camp so check with camp staff as to where stove fuel can be stored. They usually have a fuel storage area.

Label fuel containers with name and troop number.

_____ Cleaning supplies and dish washing pans

_____ Tents (2-3 person tent for before/ after or during summer camp)

not needed for dining hall meals, but might be needed for camping on Friday / Saturday before camp Check **with Camp Scoutmaster before bringing.
